

Find Your Ring Size

JG Kronenberger Fine Jewelers provides a free initial sizing for all ring orders. If you are unsure of which ring size to purchase, please follow the directions below carefully.

STEP 1: Print this page at 100% page size

Before printing make sure **page scaling is set to "none"** in the print dialogue box.

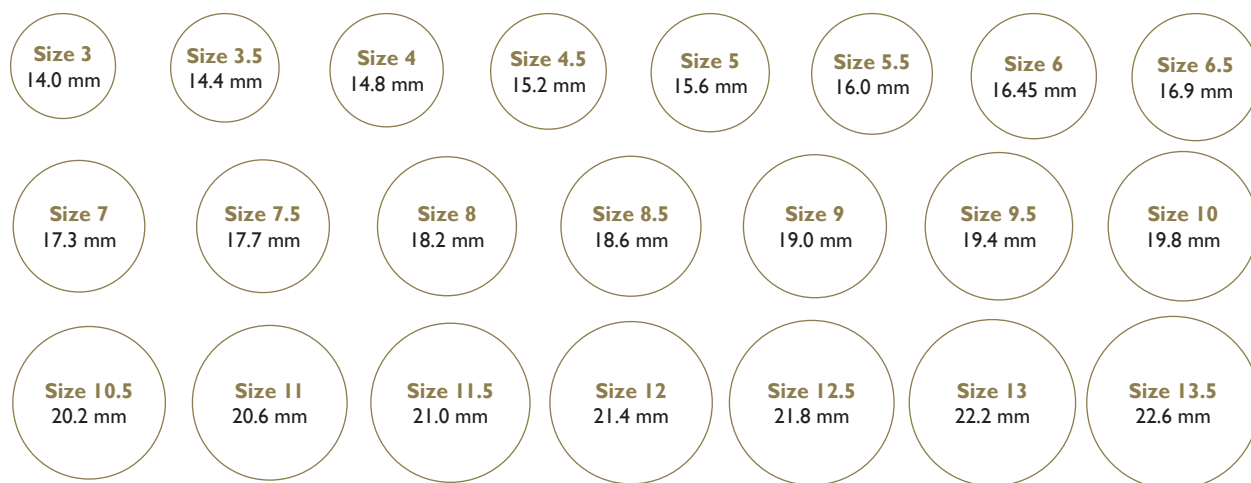
STEP 2: Confirm page size

Using a ruler, measure the bar on right. **Confirm that the bar is exactly 2 inches long.** If not, you must re-print this page at 100% size or you will not get an accurate measurement.



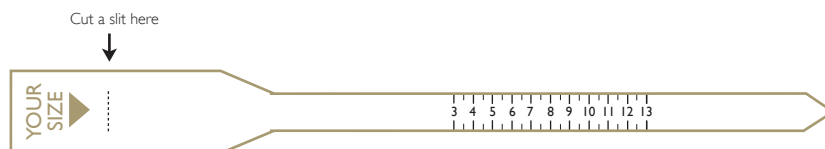
STEP 3: Measure a ring or your finger.

Measure a ring: If you have a ring that has been accurately sized for the intended finger, use the circles below as a guide. Match the **inside edge** of the ring to the closest ring size below. If your ring fall between sizes, for example between a size of 6 and 6.5, then choose a size of 6.25.



Measure your finger: If you are using the paper finger sizer, it's best to measure your finger at **the end of the day** when fingers tend to be slightly larger.

1. Carefully cut out the paper sizer below with scissors, including the small slit at the top.
2. Wrap the sizer around the intended finger with the numbers facing out. Slip the pointed end through the slit from the back side of the sizer to the front.
3. Pull the pointed end until the sizer fits tightly around your finger. The number aligned with the opening is you ring size.
